As the nose discloses subtle finesse and complexity with precious aromas of crushed rocks, sage, and blackberries, the impact of the wine produces a burst of bright intensity.

All the ingredients are there to satisfy your senses: hedonistic black fruit, fragrant acidity, striking richness and powerful tannins are in perfect balance to secure collectability and long-term drinkability.

The mouthfeel starts with great impact and continues with a lovely, soft texture and a long complex finish packed with flavors of licorice, espresso beans, boysenberry.
